THE ENDOWMENT FUNDS OF ST. PAUL'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH

Each year in the Annual Report of St. Paul's Church we review the various endowment funds with which our parish is blessed. There are two broad categories of endowment funds within our family of funds: **Unrestricted** and **Restricted**.

The Unrestricted Funds, of which there are three, are what sustain St. Paul's through periods of cash needs beyond its pledge receipts and open offerings: the Unrestricted Undesignated Endowment Fund, the Passmore Fund and the Lilly Fund. All bequests and memorial funds, unless otherwise specified by the donors, become a part of the Unrestricted Undesignated Endowment Fund. Annual withdrawals from these unrestricted funds are limited, by Vestry mandate, to no more than 4.0% of the average fair market value over the last twenty calendar quarters. The Passmore and Lilly Funds are funds named after the person or family that originally created them. Income earned in these two funds is distributed annually to support parish operations.

The Restricted Endowment Funds have been created since 2000 through the interest and dedication of members and friends of St. Paul's. They are as follows:

Music Ministry Endowment Fund established to endow music programs at St. Paul's.

<u>Orth Endowment Fund</u> – established in March 2011 through a bequest from Philip W. and Mariette C. Orth. Annual distributions are made to St. Paul's for general purposes in memory of Mr. and Mrs. Orth.

<u>Organ Endowment Fund</u> – established to endow maintenance requirements of the organ.

Children and Youth Ministries Fund – to support Sunday School and youth programs

Technology Fund: A fund created to assist in financing technological innovations deemed vital to the current and future missions of St. Paul's.

<u>Altar Guild Endowment Fund</u> – established for purposes designated by the Altar Guild that go beyond normal operating expenses associated with sacramental worship.

<u>Youth Music Ministries Endowment Fund</u> (formerly Choristers of St. Cecilia Endowment Fund) – supports youth music programs at St. Paul's.

Stained Glass Window Fund – established for the purpose of supporting the stained glass window needs at St. Paul's.

<u>M/M Leonard Campbell Jr. Window Fund</u> – endows maintenance of the window in the Morning Chapel known as "Christ Leaving the Praetorium".

<u>Seaman Family Stained Glass Window Fund</u> – created in 2014 in memory of Alonzo, William S., and Irving Seaman by Richard and June Seaman and their family foundation, Seaman-Goes Family Foundation, Inc. for the purpose of supporting the restoration and preservation of the stained glass windows of St. Paul's.

<u>Building Maintenance and Restoration Fund</u> – established to endow the future financial requirements of maintaining, restoring, and preserving our historic structure.

<u>Outreach Endowment Fund</u> – established with a preference that distributions be used to support parish involvement in feeding the hungry, serving the homeless, and other organizations serving the needy. This fund is regularly supported by contributions from the Thrift Shop, "Lenten Discipline" efforts, the "Birthday Club", and from members of the parish.

<u>Rector's Special Needs Endowment</u> – established in 2014 with a gift from Richard Seaman, Sr. and the Seaman-Goes Family Foundation, Inc. The purpose of this endowment is to provide funds, at the discretion of the Rector and with the advice and consent of the Vestry, necessary to address special missions, evangelism needs, and outreach efforts of St. Paul's.
