## **Did You Know?**

If you are age 70½ or older and required to take **Required Minimum Distributions** (RMD) from a traditional IRA, a smart way to give is through a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). With a traditional IRA (QCD's don't apply to other types), you can make a direct gift to Saint Paul's, up to \$100,000. Your gift counts towards your RMD and reduces your taxable income.
